For example, we started a (short) study in teaching English (TEFL) to be better prepared for the work in Cambodia. During our trip to Cambodia in October GOWW recommended this to us, and we followed their advise. This gives some 'extra' work, especially because I (Mart-Jan) do have a 'normal' job until we leave.
